



## FAMILY CAMP PACKING LIST

*We are so excited to share Pathfinder Island with you!  
Below please see suggested items for your stay.  
Weather can be unpredictable -- pack lots of layers and plan appropriately.  
Quantities are per a person.*

### Camp Packing List

#### Bedding and Toiletries

- 1 sleeping bag (-20F, fully synthetic and compressible)
- 1 set of twin sized sheets
- 1-2 blankets
- 1 pillow and pillow case
- 1 bath towel (quick dry material preferred)
- 1 Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Biodegradable shampoo/soap
- 1 Loofa or wash cloth

#### Clothing Items

- 3-4 pairs of underwear
- 4-6 pairs of socks (wool synthetic blend - Smartwool or Darn Tough are great!)
- 2 pair of shorts (cargo or athletic)
- 2 pairs of long pants (preferably no denim)
- 3 t-shirts (wicking/sports fabric preferred)
- 1-2 long sleeve shirts (wicking/sports fabric preferred)
- 1 fleece or wool-blend sweatshirts (medium-weight warmth that wicks)
- 1 bathing suit
- 2 pairs of pajamas/sleepwear
- 1 quality rain jacket (waterproof and breathable)

#### Accessories and Day Trip Gear

- 1 brimmed hat (ball caps OK, neck and ear coverage ideal)
- 1 day pack (Backpack)
- 2 pairs of sneakers and/or hiking boots
- 1 pair of closed-toe sandals/slip-ons
- 1 life jacket / PFD (you can borrow from us!)
- 1 headlamp or flashlight
- 1 water bottle (Nalgene or heavy, bpa free plastics preferred)

#### Optional Items

- Rain pants
- Sunglasses
- Hammock
- Books
- Deck of Cards/UNO/ETC.
- Camera
- Ball glove/ Lacrosse Stick/ETC.
- Fishing Rod
- Personal paddle
- Small pocket knife

#### **NOT Permitted or Recommended at Camp**

- Tobacco or drugs
- Aerosol cans
- Lighters or matches
- Candles or open flame lanterns
- Fireworks
- Military knives/ Weapons of any kind
- Offensive clothing
- Offensive literature or photographs
- Open-toed shoes and sandals
- Personal watercraft, bikes, or climbing gear
- Valuables, collectibles, or fine jewelry/watches
- Outside food or drink unless otherwise discussed with Camp

## **Special notes:**

**I.D. and proper documentation** is necessary for all family members crossing the border from the U.S. or other countries. Please be sure to pack your passports and/or birth certificates. Pathfinder is happy to hold all personal documents upon your arrival for safekeeping throughout your stay, otherwise please keep track of your documents.

**Camp is low-tech.** While you may carry a cellphone, computer, portable gaming system, headphones, or other tech during travel, please note we recommend young campers leave these at home unless crucial for communication during travel. For parents, we ask that you please monitor your phone usage while on the island. Digital cameras and wrist-watches are always welcome!

**Medications:** Parents, please be responsible for bringing with you and administering any medications that you or your child may need to take during your Family Camp stay.

**Camp knives** are great for whittling, craft, cord cutting, or cutting trail food. These should be small and sensible. A lock-blade pocket knife, small fixed blade with a sheath, or Swiss army knife/multitool is acceptable.

**Canoe Paddles and PFDs** are available to borrow from Camp's Paddle Shack.

**Bathing and Hygiene:** Bathing at camp is done in the pristine waters of Source Lake. Please help us keep our waters clean by packing with you biodegradable shampoos and soaps only.

**Labeling** your items before you arrive at camp is always a good idea! We advise packing with mostly "play" clothes that you don't mind getting dirty or left behind. Items left behind at an activity or gathering area will be collected and returned to you as best as possible before your departure from the island.
