Ice Out Prospects

This warmer April has brushed across the Algonquin Highlands, and the snow-melt is dramatic. Meanwhile, ice has broken from the shores, rivers are pumping like never before; BUT, lake ice can be pesky, so the ice-out predictions are as wide open as ever.

As of today, lakes along Hwy. 60 look ready to break apart. It could happen any day, or linger until early May. Consider the cooler overnight temps coming back this week, but the onset of rainy days.

The earliest ice-out was 2012 on March 29. The latest was May 15 in 1972.

First Boots on Pathfinder Island

A team of 10 staff return to the island as soon as the lake becomes liquid, immediately opening up buildings, thawing mechanical systems, and putting up tents. Next come the canoes and special efforts on the docks, ropes course and trip gear.
